<p><u>National Round for WA</u></p> <p>If a national round is to proceed in WA, a submission needs to be tabled by the end of next week 2/6.</p> <p>Approx 40 volunteers are required.</p> <p>5 key people required may not be available</p> <p>DH track need work to bring it up to national standard.</p> <p>Wamba propose looking forward to 2011 to host a national round.</p>
